ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

A minimum of 5 GCSE's including English and Mathematics at 5 and a Grade 6 in GCSE History.

WHAT IS INCLUDED

- Unit 1 –England 1509-1603.
- Unit 2 – Luther and the German Reformation.
- Unit 3 – Lancastrians, Yorkists, Henry V11, 1399-1509.
- Unit 4 –Investigation & Interpretation.

KEY FEATURES

- Assessment will take place with 3 exams at the end of the second year with Unit 1 (30%), Unit 2 (20%) and Unit 3 (30%), the Investigation and Interpretation is worth 20%.
- Coverage of history across the 15th and 16th centuries.
- Use of sources and own knowledge as part of the assessment for the A Level.
