Dear Parent/Carer

It is with pleasure that I write to you at the end of my first five weeks as Associate Principal of Maltby Academy. I have really enjoyed getting to know the students, staff and parents/carers over the last half term and I am already excited about returning in September. We are putting lots of plans in place for the start of the next academic year and I thought I would take this opportunity to explain the organisation of the first week back and when students will be expected back in the Academy.

I wrote to you recently about uniform expectations and I have updated the policy on the website. Please take time to have a look at this as we will be strictly enforcing this from September. In order to ensure a smooth start to the year for all students, we will be running a staggered start to the first week as follows:

- Monday 2nd September 2019 – INSET day for staff. No students to attend.
- Tuesday 3rd September 2019 – Year 7, 11 and 12 students ONLY. Years 7 and 11 arrival at 8.20am. Year 12 arrival at 10.00am.
- Wednesday 4th September 2019 – All year groups to attend. 8.20am arrival.

This structure will allow us to give the new Year 7 and 12 students time to familiarise themselves with the Academy and also give time with the Year 11 students to go through the plans and expectations for what will be a particularly busy and important year. It will also mean that we have a crisp start for all the other year groups on the following day.

Finally, I hope you have a great summer and I'm looking forward to working with you all over the next academic year.
